I am grateful for Fr. Bob Keiffer's availability to serve you last weekend. With my mother, I was away for the funeral rites for my Dad's sister Luella, in Hebron, North Dakota. That's the town that makes bricks. I stayed at the "Brick City Motel." Now I have only 6 aunts and uncles over the age of 90!

Luella was known to me as "Aunt Ella." There was much debate among the family if their mother's name was Luella and LuElla. Isn't it interesting that something as fundamental as the spelling your mother's name can be elusive? My father's family lacked a certain formality when it came to names. They preferred nick names to baptismal names. When my siblings and I were born, my parents would have the same conversation about names. Once they settled on a name my dad would ask, "But what are we going to call him?" As if the name wasn't *REALLY* the name.

At baptism, your name was written in heaven's book of life. God has known your name from before you were born. Even if the spelling of your name has variations, God has associated you with heaven and desires your presence with a longing only Divine Love can have. Yes, God burns with love for you. God thirsts for you. God believes in you. Don't worry if you have enough faith, give to God the faith you have and he will make up for what is lacking.
