We sent \$2,980 to Uganda this last week for the biogas project. What a wonderful gift. This totally funds the proposed project. Any excess in funds will be used for any other energy-related project. We also sent thoughts and comments from our members who have expertise in the area of energy.

I know a priest who has a standard line when he meets people, "How is your love life?" Most of the time people blush and stumble and mumble. Then he clarifies, "How is your prayer life? How is your relationship with our God who loves you very much?"

Members of the parish family are an inspiration to me. You are committed to daily prayer, to the works of mercy and love. You suffer with those who suffer, and you rejoice with those who rejoice. Thank you, and thank you all that you hold me in prayer daily. The Mass this morning was offered for the people of the parishes. Once a week there is a Mass offered for YOU.
