Here is a thought from last week's homily: *A hard heart is not a safety line, but a razor wire—it cuts the hands that want to cling to it.*

It is in its original packaging in a shoe box in my own garage." My protest didn't matter. I was re-awarded the "H" and now I have two. Eventually, when I find my shoe box again, I will put MY "H" on top and the two letters will live in the musty darkness until I die. My great nieces and nephews will sort through my play scripts, pins and mementos and wonder what to do with it all.
