Here is a thought from last week's homily: *N., you have become a new creation, and have clothed yourself in Christ. See in this white garment the outward sign of your Christian dignity. With your family and friends to help you by word and example, bring that dignity unstained into the everlasting life of heaven.*

The calendar of Saints is a rich source of inspiration for the Christian life. This week alone we celebrated St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, St. Ignatius of Antioch, St. Luke, St. John Brebeuf and St. Paul of the Cross. I hope that you are able to include in your daily routine a moment to know who it is the Church remembers, what they are remembered for, and to let them inspire you!

How can you do this? I subscribe to the *Magnificat*, a monthly publication that includes the liturgical calendar and inspirational stories of the saints. Others use *Living with Christ*. There are many others.

I also use an app called Catholic Calendar. It's free! Find a way that works for you, and let these holy men and women be a guide and an influence in your life.

St. Luke was a physician, artist and evangelist. He was a companion of St. Paul. Much of the Gospel of Luke is based on the preaching of St. Paul. St. Luke also wrote the Acts of the Apostles, which narrates the early history of the Church up to Paul's first stay in Rome.
