Here is a thought from last week's homily: *If perfection were the sole criteria for being admitted into a trade, then there would be no craftsmen in the world. We would all be aspiring to something and doing nothing.*

I watched a movie, *The Heart of Man*, directed by Eric Esau. It is an amazing reflection on the love God the Father has for us. Our sins do not diminish God's love for us. Our rejection of God does not cause the Father to reject us. Our absence in prayer does not mean that the Father has written us off. Our shame does not mean that the Father despises us. God wants your heart. God will never desist in the Father's pursuit of you.

This movie is not for the weak of heart. It is not for children. If you believe yourself to be unlovable or unforgivable, the movie may be for you.

When my father died there was a strange creation in his shop. Picture a square piece of 1/2 inch oak, about six inches by six inches. There are two 12-inch dowels attached to the base, exactly opposite from each other. The dowels are connected on the top by a oak "bar," like a handle. That is it. What is it for? Nobody knows. For the last 15 years my mother has used it as a napkin holder.

One of my sisters was home and mentioned that she felt "shorted" at the distribution of memorabilia for Dad. Mother gave her the "what's- it-for?" and she is happy.

I was in a thrift store last week and came across something very similar to Dad's mystery creation. I bought it. I mailed it to Mother with no note and no return address. Will she think it is a gift from heaven? No! She will presume that one of her sons made it for her.

Be kind, gentle, generous and loving to each other; especially during times of grief and stress. Never be surprised when grief endures, even for decades.
