Here is a thought from last week's homily: *What if we are the virgins, the lamp is the light of our baptismal faith and the flask of oil is the good works of love and mercy?*

I considered offering the following as a homily for one of the hunters Masses this year. Instead, I offer it to you here..."We were people of the buffalo. They gave us our tipis, our clothes, our meat, our robes, tools, shields, bowstrings, sewing thread, and runners for our winter sleds. We lived side by side with the buffalo. Their life gave us life, and we hunted them only for what we needed. We had many ceremonies to thank the buffalo and honor its spirit..." This reminds me of the Canticle of Daniel (Daniel 3:56-88): " Bless the Lord, all you works of the Lord. Praise and exalt him above all forever... You dolphins and all water creatures, bless the Lord, All birds of the air, bless the Lord. All you beasts, wild and tame, bless the Lord, You sons of men, bless the Lord."
