Here is a thought from last week's homily: *The Sacrament of the Sick is a pouring out of God's grace for the good of the person. The Sacrament can relieve anxiety, mend a broken spirit and give strength against temptations.*

February 6 was the 17th anniversary of the death of my daddy. On that afternoon I was playing pinochle with three widows in Ada. Seventeen years ago cell phones were barely popular. I was still wearing a pager. I got paged to call my friend, Fr. Bob. I called him, and he said, "I need to share with you the hardest thing I will ever say to you. Your father died this afternoon." After I hung up the phone I turned to the ladies and said, "My daddy died." As I heard myself say this, I was aware that I referred to my father as "daddy." Where did that come from?

Three times in the New Testament Jesus refers to his Father as "Abba." In Aramaic this is a term of both affection and confidence. We are told that there is no word in English that corresponds directly to Abba. All of this was present in a singular moment. "My daddy died."

I told them that I needed to leave. Aggie, the hostess, wanted to serve dessert before I left. I think that she was really looking forward to sharing her strawberry short cake. I told her that I really just needed to leave. She asked me to wait while she wrapped the rectangle of angel food cake in tin foil for me to take home. I left her apartment with a foil full of cake in my hand. Not thinking about the cake at all, I put it in the trunk of my blue Park Avenue. Several months later I was cleaning out the car, and I found this odd-looking foil package. "What is that?!"

I smiled as I unwrapped the cake and felt terrible guilty for not enjoying Aggie's proud dessert. I never told Aggie this story. She, too, died many years ago. May she rest in peace. For her, eat some cake before Lent begins.
