Here is a thought from last week's homily: *When the leper approached him, Jesus was moved with pity. Translated, the word pity literally means, "to have the bowels yearn." The whole body of Jesus was filled with compassion for the leper, as it is for us.*

My friend James sent me an obituary on Tuesday regarding the death of a 69-year-old man from England. Apparently one of my friend's hobbies is reading obituaries from around the world! He commented, "I came across this obituary and worried that this might be me in a few years...I lost it when I read the final line, 'he suffered a heart attack between the dressed crab and the boeuf en croute.'" This is one way to get our heads into the season of Lent—we could write our own obituary.

James looked at his life through the lens of an another and saw some things he doesn't like. The Lent question is, "What are you going to do about that?" One option is to continue willfully down the same path and hope for a judgment that is long on mercy and short on justice. Another option is to identify the areas in our life which would cause us embarrassment or shame and amend them. We can repent and believe in the gospel!

One of the antiphons for the distribution of ashes is, "Let us change our garments to sackcloth and ashes, let us fast and weep for before the Lord, that our God, rich in mercy, might forgive us our sins."

Jesus is filled with compassion for us. This divine yearning is wasted when we continue stumbling down the wrong path and make no attempt to change direction or our hearts.

This Lent I will be asking Jesus to replace my stony heart with a natural heart. I will ask him to reveal to me my sins and give me true sorrow and amendment of life.

We are pleased to announce the beginning of the Diocesan Annual Appeal. The Diocesan goal for the Appeal has been raised for the first time in three years by \$10,000 and is now \$900,000. This goal is shared and pro-rated among our 66 parishes based on the prior year's offertory. Our parish goal for 2018 as \$17,998, which is a decrease of \$1,290.
