Here is a thought from last week's homily: *It is good to consider the sins which we struggle with day in and day out. Are there other sins associated with them? If we renounce the smaller sins, can we avoid the more serious sins?*

I saw many kids and a few adults strolling the parks dressed in Harry Potter robes and carrying Harry Potter wands. I particularly enjoyed watching the younger kids with their wands. A few times I watched little boys censuring themselves, as if they talked themselves down from using their magic wands to turn their siblings into frogs or to zap them into nothingness.

The imagination is a marvelous gift. In the imagination, vocations are born; little girls become mommies or nuns and little boys become daddies or priests. Sometimes we endeavor to filter from possibility what kids otherwise might imagine. In other words, we can kill their dreams so that they conform more closely to our vision of life and reality.

Imagination needs to be fed with time and ideas. As part of our Lenten observance during our 125th anniversary year, we will have a parish mission. The mission will include the movie, *The Letters*. Plan to bring your children, even little children. It will be fuel for their imaginations. Maybe even the beginning of a religious vocation.

And no, I have not felt like zapping any of you into nothingness. I like you!
