Obedience is a sign of trust and a surrender of selfishness. There was no need to take more than an omar, for God would provide for tomorrow when tomorrow came.

I wandered through a store closing sale on Monday. It was so challenging to not take more than an omar! Shirts were on sale—80% off! Do I need another shirt? No. Do I trust that God will provide for today and for tomorrow, too? I do...but...it is such a good deal!

When it comes to obedience, sales and good deals do not matter. I need an omar each day, and I should not take more than an omar. To do so simply extends my time in the desert, the place where I learn obedience. The place where I learn to trust God.

We have not learned these lessons well. Yet God still loves us and calls us to faithfulness.
