Here is a thought from my homily last weekend (you are not forgetful...you didn't hear it!): *When we lie, we put a foot in Satan's camp, and he will try to seduce us all the more.*

Last weekend I had Masses for Fr. Tony so that he could be here to begin the Parish Mission. Here are some highlights from Masses in Nevis and LaPorte.

The parishioners were very hospitable. I noticed them greeting one another at every door. Their warm smiles and friendly gestures created a wonderful atmosphere for the celebration of Mass.

Before Mass on Sunday Morning in Nevis, there were about 15 kids running laps in the social hall and screaming their lungs out. One of the mothers commented to me, "We have found that if we let the kids run before Mass, they are more attentive when Mass begins."

After the Saturday evening Mass, a beautiful retired couple took me out for a meal. It was touching that they wanted to share with me every moment of their lives. The outing was to include a tour of his new hunting "shack," but the evening got too late. Darkness fell before the chicken was served.

They are about to break ground on a new rectory in Nevis. A bit of history: both Nevis and Akley had Catholic Churches. It was decided that they would merge, and they chose to keep the church in Nevis as it was in better repair. When the parishes were merged, they took a new name: Our Lady of the Pines. The rectory was in Akley, and that is where Fr. Tony resides today. The new rectory will be building Nevis. It was exciting to see the blueprint hanging in the church and a fundraising thermometer next to it. They anticipate the mercury to burst through the top of the thermometer when they sell the present rectory. So, if anybody is looking for a 1970's split level in Akley, I know who you can call.
