Here is a thought from last week's homily: *Temptation reveals the plan of the evil one for his spiritual warfare against YOU. How much better it is to renounce temptation than to confess sin! We need grace for both. Jesus implores us, don't wait for grace. At the first opportunity, reveal temptation to the confessor.*

Sometimes we accumulate more spiritual reading, prayer cards and religious articles than we need or have room for in our homes. There is a table outside the parish office to help! Let's call it the **Religious Items Exchange**.

You are welcome to browse this table and take what you would like. If you have items at home that you would like to send to a new home, bring them to the table. At the end of Lent I will appropriately dispose of items that are left. Items that are likely blessed I will burn or bury. Other items will be appropriately recycled or discarded.

It is good to fill our homes and our lives with items of faith. They are a constant reminder of our commitment to Jesus. They inspire us and encourage us. One time I had a roommate who needed to have a clock visible from any chair in the house and in every room. That was a lot of clocks! I think of the faith in the same way. I want to see a sign of it from every chair and in every room. It helps me remember that I belong to God and that the Communion of Saints are always present to me.

May God grant you a blessed Lent and a home filled with reminders of our call to holiness.
