Here is a thought from last week's homily: *When we feel a need for an opinion, what we need may in fact be a gift of the Holy Spirit.*

For the season of Lent, I have been presenting the 25 instructions our Lord gave to Sr. Faustina for combatting spiritual evil. It is important to remember that Sr. Faustina was a nun living in a convent. Her vocation called her to live in a unique way, at least compared to our lives in the world with families as the center of our faith. I am trying to translate these instructions for life in today's world. If something doesn't fit your life very well, don't worry! It may be a problem of translation or relevance.

The Roman poet Ovid wrote about Sisyphus. Sisyphus was a sinner condemned for all eternity to roll a boulder uphill and then watch it roll back again. This last week we heard the story of the crippled man who sat beside the pool of Bethesda. For 38 years he tried to get into the healing water, but there was never room for him when he got to its edge.

Sometimes our lives seem futile, that we do the same thing over and over again. Insane. Frustrating. Everything changes for the crippled man when he meets Jesus. If you are pushing a boulder up a hill only to see it roll down again, how about asking Jesus to take the load? If you cannot get to the healing water, look up and see Jesus at your side. Jesus is the well-spring of new life.
