Here is a thought from last week's homily: *Let us humble ourselves so that others know we have accomplished nothing by our own will and strength. Jesus makes life-giving bread from the crumbs of our lives. He has opened the door to paradise.*

I have been a little unsettled by my mother's collapse last week. She was combing her hair in the bathroom, as she does every morning, and collapsed. She crashed into the bathroom vanity. Suffering only a bruised forehead, black eye, sore neck, sore leg and shoulder—she is fine! By the time you read this she will have had an appointment with a cardiac electrophysiologist. This medical specialty focuses on the heart's timing. Mom's heart is beating too slowly.

When I was a kid, my dad used to talk about the end of his life. He used to say, "I will live until I am 88 years old." He died when he was seventy. This year Mom is 88! Who knows what to make of all that?

Speaking of Dad, do you remember that Dad owned and managed a car dealership? For my entire life at home, neither Mom or Dad owned a car. They drove cars from the dealership. Mom would have a car until there was a perspective buyer, then it would be reconditioned, and she would get another. Still today it seems odd for me to "own" a car and to drive a car for more than a month! The summer Dad died, Mom bought a new car. It is a 2001 Mercury Sable and is a rusted old car today. I am sure it is the last car she will own. It has about 60,000 miles on it. Today she has trouble with the battery, because she does not drive it enough. Maybe the car needs to see an electrophysiologist.

It seems that I have enough excitement in my life to keep my heart rate at a normal pace. Thank you for all you do to keep me electrified!
