Here is a thought from last week's homily: Why would I come to church and think about golf when I can be on the golf course thinking about God?

Thank you for the prayers for my mother. Her appointment with the cardiologist last week went well—there is nothing wrong with her heart. The doctor talked to her about her daily routine.
