Here is a thought from last week's homily: *God has made a great act of faith in us by entrusting the church to us. We are human; we are vulnerable to weakness and sin.*

This week, the majority of the priests of the Diocese of Crookston are gathered with the bishop participating in a program called *Good Shepherds Good Leaders*. When asked why I am not participating, I have commented, "I am comfortable with subjecting the parishes to the risk of my present administrative competence." I trust that you will let me know of my deficiencies, and we can work on them together!

I was not able to see my mother on Mother's Day. I did call her. Her day was filled with greetings and visits from children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. My brother Jim saw to it that she was treated with good food, and others provided the drink and the cards to be shuffled and dealt. My sister Jeanne once commented, "We were so blessed to have *our* parents." I agree.

Mother has always been practical, and she abhors anything that smacks of wastefulness. She thanked me for *not* sending a card: the money can be used for better things; she feels guilty for throwing them away. My dad and his sister Clare exchanged the SAME birthday card for about 40 years. The card wasn't funny or tender.

Still, I feel my status as favorite son may be at risk. How about we do this: You can take your gently used Mother's Day cards and send them to my mother. Just add a "Love, David" at the bottom.
