During his homily for Confirmation Bishop Hoepfner talked about glory, that united to the Body of Christ we are the glory of the Father. He also said, "...you can't kiss a talking woman..."

I attended a family gathering on Mother's Day. Let me tell you about the grills.

My brother Jim hosted the gathering and had three grills fired up. One was a Green Egg. This grill was a gift to Jim, and he likes to use it to honor the gift-giver. The second grill was a campsite grill that Jim salvaged from the city park. This is a rusty three-sided metal box with no lid and mounted to a pole. When I was a kid these grills were scattered throughout the city park. I wonder if they were constructed in the 1920's so that the down-trodden had a place to cook and socialize. The third grill came into Jim's possession by an act of mercy. More appropriately an act of salvage. It had been abandoned by the city's recycling. Jim thought it was too good to not take home. It has an external fire box, so the food is never near the flame.

Why, you ask, did one small family gathering require three grills? It didn't! But each grill had a story and the story came to life as the fire of each grill was ignited.

You have a story about how you have come to know Jesus. You have been a witness to miracles, to mercy and to love. The faith comes to life when you tell these stories. The fire of faith is ignited in the hearts of all who hear your voice.

Imagine a grill with no fire. Hungry people look to you to bring the ember, the spark that will ignite the fire of love. At the end of the day, to share faith is far more fulfilling than to share a pork chop.

I felt timeless when I stabbed a pork chop from the park grill with a stick I had sharpened with a dull knife. Gather your family. Share some food. Share some stories. Share the faith.
