*In Father David's absence, I would like to share with you the gist of the homily I heard on Mother's Day at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Hugo, MN. Perhaps the imagery will grab you as it did me. Marlys*

The homily began with illustrating the difference between *faith* and *trust*. With *faith*, we believe, with *trust* we relinquish control. I have faith that my vehicle will get me safely down the highway to whatever my destination; I do not trust that it will be safe in a blinding downpour or in the path of a tornado. I have faith that my children and grandchildren love me; I do not trust that they will always and in every circumstance do as I would do. I have faith that my doctor will do her best to care for my health; I do not trust that she can always fix a troubling diagnosis.

Most of us have a firm faith in Jesus Christ. At some point in our life, someone, some event, some reading—something—brings us to a consciousness of Jesus, of who He is, of how He loves us. We develop faith. With faith we ask Jesus for healing, for security, for loving relationships, for good weather for the family picnic. Perhaps we look for proof that the Lord answers our prayers, getting discouraged if our prayers seem not to be answered. No matter what, most of us maintain our faith in Jesus and His healing love.

Using a tandem bicycle as an analogy, with faith we have invited Jesus onto our bicycle with us. We keep Him near us, helping us to pedal our way through life. When we are sick, we ask for His healing. When we are in danger, we ask for His protection. When the devil is knocking on our door, we ask Him to push the devil away. We ask Him to help us skirt deserts and mountains, storms and droughts, blinding sun and gloomy darkness, and tripping over rocks or slogging through bogs. We have faith that He will pedal along with us around these obstacles. We steer; we celebrate Jesus and enjoy His company; we consider Him a wonderful passenger, pedaling in tandem with us as He loves and encourages us.

As our relationship with Jesus strengthens and matures from faith to trust, we have the opportunity to relinquish the front seat and the handlebars, giving Jesus control of our lives while He continually encourages us to "just keep pedaling." With trust, we move from the front to the rear seat. With trust, we cooperate as He takes us where He knows we need to go. With trust, we relinquish our own destination and our own way there. With trust in Jesus, with trust in His love, with trust in His knowledge and judgment of where we should go and the route there, we pedal from the rear through whatever territory He chooses and at whatever pace He sets. We hang on to Jesus with all our might and try to enjoy both the pace and the scenery along the way.
