Here is a thought from last week’s homily: *Every encounter with Jesus is for our own well-being and more. The more is his commission. His peace and contentment are not for us alone; they are for the world.*

What do you remember from your Confirmation? I was about 12 years old. I chose the name Daniel because my brother Daniel was my sponsor. I remember being terrified that the Bishop would ask me a question. He did not. I don’t remember the anointing, the prayer of Confirmation, or anything else from the day.

If you are a sponsor, think about the significance of the opportunity you have to encourage faith, to practice love and to be a beacon of hope in a world that seems too often dark. You may be the only thing the candidate remembers about Confirmation.

I visited several cemeteries on Memorial Day, but none where my own family rests. St. Benedict taught the monks, “Keep death before you daily.” It is good to remember that we were made to know, love and serve God in this life and to be happy with Him forever in heaven. When I visit a cemetery, I don’t spend much time imagining that those who are now resting on earth may actually be HAPPY with God in heaven! We ought to do our best to echo this happiness on earth. The world’s darkness will be lightened by Christian joy, and conquered by the power of the cross and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Jesus, I trust in you.
