Here is a thought from last week's homily, *The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought.*

I will be leaving for my mission trip to Uganda on Sunday, July 30. I will be back in the parish on Thursday, August 17. Thank you for the offer of prayers. Many have offered to send money as well. I would like to see the orphanage first hand and its administration before I recommend it as a destination of a tithe. Thank you, however, for your generosity and kindness.

Some of the 200 kids in the orphanage were born with AIDS. I have been aware of any cuts and scrapes on my body, trying to get them healed up. I have eczema, on and off. Mostly off these days. I have had a little patch of irritated skin on the ring finger of my right hand...for months. I decided to get serious about it, so I have been smearing it with my eczema cream and covering it with a band aid. In three days it was healed. It makes me wonder...

What are the irritations in our lives? What drives us crazy, but we have decided to live with it, complain about it and be grumpy even though there may be something we can do about it? An offence can be forgiven. A wound can be given to Jesus for healing. Sometimes we may need spiritual direction or some counseling, but why live with a sore if it can be healed?

A light bulb was out in my garage for about a month. Every evening that I would come home late I would wonder why I haven't found time to replace the bulb as I gingerly crept into the house hoping not to injure myself along the way. It takes few minutes to change a bulb, even when it requires a step ladder. It takes a few days to heal an eczema finger. What challenge can you solve this week?

Thank you to Fr. Bob Keiffer who will be with you on the weekends, Fr. Mario Prada who will be with you on the Holy Day of Obligation (August 15) and Msgr. Timothy McGee who will assist with any funerals (don't die!) and emergency needs.

Thank you for your prayers. I am traveling to a place with no electricity or running water. I will not be accessible by phone. I will check my email when I can. See you in three weeks.
