They share bathrooms and the rest of the house.

When I left the home on Saturday afternoon for Mass, my sister-in-law said to me, "Pray for us." I don't think she was asking for a particular prayer, like, "Save us from each other!" I brought the needs and intentions of those families to Mass with me, as you do each time you enter the Lord's House.

What is the recipe for peace and joy in your family? Whatever it is, it must include communication, charity, mercy and forgiveness. St. Paul would say, "...there are faith, hope and love, and the greatest of these is love." Love one another. Do it well, especially in stressful times and when you are aware of your own brokenness or that of another.
