This was beautiful and could not have been rehearsed. "This is why a man leaves his father and mother and clings to his wife, and the two of them become one body."

In good times and in bad, run into the arms of your spouse. There is no better place to share joy or to rebuild failure. In sickness and in health, collapse into the arms of your spouse. There is no better place to praise God for every gift or to live the mercy of faith.

It is always true that love can bear all things. It is a choice to run into the arms of your spouse, even when you are fearful or ashamed, and allow love to believe, hope and endure.

This is a lesson for all of your married life; practice well and then accept with joy whatever comes.

There is a fair amount of bookkeeping in keeping track of who needs to/has completed the Safe Environment requirement; this bookkeeping is much easier if everyone gets this done by August 31.
