Dear Sacred Heart Parish Family,

I am writing to update you on how my fundraising is going, to thank you for all your love and support, to let you know about my year ahead (as much as I know), and ask for prayers. When I got accepted to serve the NET 2017-2018 school year in the beginning of February, I was nervous about the fundraising aspect of preparing to serve with NET Ministries. I knew and still know that God provides but, at the moment, I was nervous about raising \$6,000 by myself in the seven months before I was to leave for my year of mission. Initially, I contemplated just working mega hours and just pay my way myself. While I am not sure how much of it I could have made myself, I was gently reminded of the ministry that is done through asking for financial support from others. The fundraising aspect of NET for the U.S. is called Ministry Partner Development. When we, as missionaries, accept the call to serve, we ask others to collaborate with us financially. Like Rachel talked about in her letter, we are doing the work for the Lord throughout the country which you, our partners, are not easily able to do, while you partner to help us financially, which we are not able to do. So, together, we can reach many more youth and adults and bring the Gospel to them each day! It truly is a partnership that would not work without the tremendous support you, my church family, has given me.

Right now, I have raised a little over \$8,000, which is over my minimum goal of \$6,000! Thank you so much for all the support and prayers! Any money raised over the minimum goal goes toward the total cost it takes to send each missionary, which is roughly \$20,000. The funds go toward the cost of training, traveling, health insurance, and the living stipend we receive each month.

To start my fundraising, I sent out letters; I was advised to call people a few weeks later to follow up on the letters. I was very nervous about this and hoped and prayed that, if people were called to donate, they would be by the prompting of the Holy Spirit and not by my calling them. Then, I came home to Sacred Heart and did the Parish Appeal with Rachel, and exceeded my minimum goal in the spring. Thank you so much for that! God is so good! Your generous support helped confirm my decision to drop everything and follow Christ during this next year, something I have wanted to do ever since I was in junior high. You all have made this parish a beautiful place to grow up and grow in my faith, making me feel at home in the church and at home with Jesus at the center of my life and the center of my heart.

This past Thursday, August 17, I left for training in West St. Paul; then I will go to Camp Wapo in Wisconsin for more staff training. A few weeks later, we come back; then on September 12, at 7pm, there is a Commissioning Mass. This is the Mass where we figure out what team I am on and whether I will be on a parish team or traveling team. After this day, I will finally know the general idea of what my assignment will be during the year. I am so excited to see how the Lord uses me this year and how Mother Mary uses me as a fit instrument in her Immaculate hands.
