Here is a thought from last week's homily: *When Jesus asks us to do something, our first response cannot be to do the math.*

I finally witnessed a gospel parable first hand. A little boy came forward for the children's collection. He put into the basket a single coin. It was a penny. He seemed to be deeply satisfied to give all he had.

I looked at his coin in the basket next to a twenty-dollar bill. And a ten. And a five. And single dollars. Was his gift greater than all the others? No. But it is possible that his sacrifice was greater.

If you feel like you have nothing left to give, give whatever you can scrape up...give it to Jesus. He fed 5,000 with five loaves. He can work a miracle with your meager gift. But not if you keep it for yourself, not if you judge it yourself to be unworthy of giving.

It is time to renew Safe Environment Certifications. If you work/volunteer in any capacity for Sacred Heart Parish with either youth or vulnerable adults, this certification is required by the Diocese every year. Go to: <http://www.crookston.org/secertification> to complete your certification online. If you do not do it online, get a hard copy of the information in the kiosk in the vestibule. Let's everybody get this done by August 31. There is a fair amount of bookkeeping in keeping track of who needs to/has completed the Safe Environment requirement; this bookkeeping is much easier if everyone gets this done by August 31.
