Dear Parish Family,

July 26, 2017

I am writing to give you an update on how my fundraising is going and to thank you for the support I have received. NET asked me to raise a minimum of \$6,500 and work towards a maximum of \$17,000 to help them cover the costs of our training, travel expenses, health insurance and our stipend as missionaries. I have to admit that the thought of raising that much money scared me at first, but now as I look back on the past 6 months, I know I should not have worried. God has provided me with all I need through my brothers and sisters and in Christ.

NET Ministries has received a little over \$9,800 to help pay for my year as a missionary. Concert proceeds and other donations paid for my passport, two round trips to Ireland, my visa, foreign transaction fees and the exchange rate (1 euro= 1.16 US dollars). In addition to this, I received stamps and address labels for my fundraising letters, and refreshments to serve at my concerts. Every single need I faced, was met with overwhelming generosity! Even near the end, when I had narrowed my list of needs down to just a good pair of shoes, someone approached me a few days later pressing money into my palm saying "This is for if you need to buy some good clothes or anything before you leave." Astonished, I stammered "...I do need a new pair of shoes."

At the Last Supper Jesus washed his disciples' feet and said "If I, therefore, the master and teacher, have washed your feet, you ought to wash one another's feet. I have given you a model to follow, so that as I have done for you, you should also do" (John 13:14-15.) This is Christ's explanation of what it means to be a missionary. We should not just tell people about the Father's love, but show it to them in a personal way; to love one another as He has loved us.

The way I see it, you have washed my feet. Because you have been missionaries to me through your donations, prayers, and encouragement, I am about to cross an ocean to wash the feet of others! What an incredible reminder of how our actions and prayers *do* make a difference! I thank you for all you have done, I promise to keep you in my prayers, and I humbly ask that you continue to pray for me, especially through the intercession of my Confirmation saint, St. Mother Teresa. When you pray that I can imitate Christ and be a good missionary, the prayers benefit not only me, but every person I come in contact with on my journeys. Pray for me. Pray for each other; and be missionaries in all you do.
