Last week you heard about the needs of Fr. Joseph's diocese in Ghana. Did something from his homily stick in your mind? Share it with someone!

From Ghana I want to take you back to Uganda. Ghana is in the far west of Africa; Uganda is in the east.

Today I am thinking about personal space. When was a kid, there were 13 people in a four-bedroom house. We did have the luxury of three toilets, three sinks, one shower and one bathtub. We all had dresser drawers and places to hang clothing. One year my parents got us little cedar chests for Christmas—big enough for about two decks of cards. I loved my cedar chest. It had a tiny padlock, which had the strength of a twist tie, but still it provided a sense of personal space and privacy. I can still remember locking my most prized possessions in the chest, including some steel ball-bearings I salvaged from a busted wheel bearing.

The kids at Miryante orphanage in Uganda do not have personal space. They share a single bedroom with 10-15 other kids. There are no dressers or closets. The kids are permitted to have a trunk, but few have them. Nothing is personal. Imagine 120 pair of flip flops piled outside a humble classroom. The kids were always barefoot when inside a building. When class was over, do you think they left with the same flops? Not a chance! The kids are necessarily detached from personal belongings. I think of the gospel instruction to missionaries: take nothing with you on the journey, no bag, no money sack, no second tunic. Each day Jesus says to these kids, "Take nothing with you." And they joyfully consent.

Many of the kids wore rosaries around their necks. It now occurs to me that they had no place to keep them. If they did not wear them, they would not possess them. We gave the kids prayer cards, which I will share with you in the weeks to come. Most of the prayer cards were left behind or seen scattered throughout the orphanage village the next day. Were they that careless? No. Remember, they have no personal space. There was no place for them to put a prayer card, even the size of a business card. It would be like someone giving me an elephant—where would I put it?

We not only have much, but we have places to put it! We can still foster in ourselves a spirit of poverty and detachment. We do this, in part, by sharing what we have in small ways. And sometimes in big ways.

I invite you to contribute to the funding of a biogas recovery system which the orphanage hopes to build. It is a simple system which ferments manure and harvests the gas, which can be used to fuel simple burners for their kitchen. Now and for every day they have been open, they have been cooking three meals a day on wood fires. You can mark an envelope "Miryante Biogas" and put it in the regular collection basket. I hope to send them the full amount (\$2,000) by the end of the year.

Let us be grateful for every gift we enjoy, each of which comes from the loving hand of God.
