A thought from last week's homily: *You smell good!*

One of the joys of priesthood is the experience of the beautiful community that gathers for daily Mass. Thank you to those who are able to extend the Lord's Day to every day of the week! We have discontinued the use of the small chapel for daily Mass. We gather in the main church according to our daily Mass schedule.

My dad died of a sudden heart attack while ice fishing on Lake of the Woods on February 6, 2001. He was 70 years old. I have often wondered if his death was harder for us because it was sudden. There was no chance to say good bye, to ask for forgiveness, to cherish a moment or to say "I love you!" For fourteen years I have needed to lean into Divine providence, trusting that Jesus is able to bring life from death no matter how or when or why a death occurs.

A sudden death brings into sharp focus the intentionality with which we live each day. It reminds us to cherish one another, to seek reconciliation, to say what needs to be said and to refrain from speaking when words are designed to hurt.

Here is a prayer that can be prayed when we are trying to make sense of a sudden death: *Lord our God, you are always faithful and quick to show mercy. Our sister was suddenly taken from us. Come swiftly to her aid, have mercy on her, and comfort her family and friends by the power and protection of the cross. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.*
