

My dear friends in Christ,

What determines good human relationships? Constant interaction with people could be the main factor in building human relations. Constancy alone does not strengthen good relationships. People who think alike stick together fast. People who work together for similar causes bind themselves in close ties. Blood relations could be one of the most important causes of bringing people together in good, healthy, emotional relationships. However, in my personal experience, some of the best relationships I encountered in my life had been through friends. Friends nurture, nourish and help us to grow through their consistent enriching presence in our lives. Jesus proposes a different basis for human relationship.

When Jesus' mother and brothers were waiting to see him, he raised this question: "Who is my mother and who are my brother and sister? One who is ready to listen to my word and fulfill the will of my Father is my brothers and sisters." When Jesus put listening to his word as a precondition for being the children of God, then his way of building relationships begins with being obedient to the word of God. It is not just paying attention to the word of God that brings good relationship between God and us but our readiness to discern His will through the attentive listening to his word and being faithful to His will. If we meet people of such faithfulness to God, then the divine vibrancy of being in constant touch with God's word and His will immediately connect us at a different level. Relationships built on such foundations will stay strong till we leave this earth.

Jesus is not denying the need to develop good relationships within our families. He is inviting us to extend our horizon of relationships beyond our family circle. We all have such healthy and good relationships outside our family circle. However, we do not grow deeper in such outside the family relationships. If we come under the banner of building human relations through the word of God and being united in doing God's will, then our relationships would be the ideal ones Jesus wants us to develop in our lives. If many desire to build good relationships as God wants, there won't be too many conflicts of interests. There won't be too many wars and civil conflicts. There won't be too many crimes and violence. Let us try to build relationships at such a level; then God's Kingdom will certainly be in our midst.
