Your hearing is just fine! You really are hearing the ringing of bells during Mass. The steeple bell rings just prior to the start of Mass. This calls people to the Mass and is a sign to those who will not be here that a miracle is about to happen.

Sounding the small bell during Mass does call our attention to the action of the Mass should our minds have wondered. Small children and non-Catholics are alerted that something marvelous and mysterious is happening. More than that, this bell is an audible sign of our joyous praise and thanksgiving—the Lord Jesus has come to us again.

If you come to daily Mass, you are aware that we are using the simple Latin chant for the *Holy Holy* and the *Lamb of God*. Eventually I would like to include the *Memorial Acclamation* in our Latin repertoire. This small dose of Latin can connect us to the Mass as it was prayed by our ancestors. It is also an acknowledgment that the Church, since the Second Vatican Council, has many times reminded us that the use of Latin is to be preserved, and that the faithful are to know how to say or sing in Latin those parts of the Mass that pertain to them.

The use of Latin at daily Mass is not a prelude to the introduction of the whole Mass in Latin. In fact, I do not have the language facility to say Mass in Latin! If you appreciate this small measure of Latin, rejoice! If you struggle with it, do not worry; it will not grow.
