Here is a thought from Bishop Hoepfner from last week's DAA video, *Faith is strong in the Diocese of Crookston. I see it in your eagerness to know God and to serve him in our parish communities. I know YOU through the DAA prayer cards you send each year asking for my prayers.*

There is a canonical principle that says whenever someone has an obligation in the Church, there is a corresponding right. For example, all Catholics have an obligation to support the Church with tithes of time, talent and treasure. Corresponding to this obligation, all Catholics have a right to receive the services of the Church's ministers.

We can change the language from law to Lent. You can FAST from spending all of your money and offer a tithe to the poor, the parish and to the 2016 DAA; you can FEAST on the service you receive from your pastor and your bishop and his curia.

Here are some other Lenten thoughts about *fast and feast*. (From Brother Rex Anthony Norris, LittlePortionHermitage.org)

- Fast from judging others; Feast on the Christ dwelling in them.
- Fast from thoughts of illness; Feast on the healing power of God.
- Fast from words that pollute; Feast on phrases that purify.
- Fast from discontent; Feast on gratitude.
- Fast from anger; Feast on patience.
- Fast from pessimism; Feast on optimism.
- Fast from worry; Feast on divine providence.
- Fast from complaining; Feast on appreciation.
- Fast from bitterness; Feast on forgiveness.
- Fast from lethargy; Feast on enthusiasm.
- Fast from idle gossip; Feast on purposeful silence.
