Here is a thought from last week's homily, *All of the earthly things that you use to pass time and distract you from your cares, they are ultimately a table of malnourishment. You eat plenty but it leaves you bloated and still hungry. Not the Word of God. Every time it will give you something you need, especially when you don't know you need something.*

A mother and her daughter-in-law did not see eye to eye. Finally, the daughter-in-law said, "You will never understand my choices until you have walked in my shoes." This is a good description of the Stations of the Cross. We choose to walk in the shoes of Jesus in order to gain the slightest understanding of what he has done for us. It is OK to permit your religious imaginations run with the images. During a time of prayer, close your eyes and see Jesus condemned. Watch him take up his cross. Hear the crack of his knee when he falls the first time. Accompany Veronica as she winds her way through the crowd in order to get close to the path Jesus will walk. Listen to the cries of the women of Jerusalem. Let the pounding of the hammer as the nails sink into his flesh resonate in your body.

Simon of Cyrene helped Jesus carry the cross. Today Jesus suffers with all who suffer. Many people, near and far, labor under the burden of heavy crosses; grief, sickness, and fear are but a few. People suffer so terribly when their marriages struggle and fail and when their children make choices that are not consistent with the faith. Think about who it is in your life that carries a heavy cross. Can you ease the burden just a bit? For a little while?

Redeemer Lord, give us vision to recognize you in the needy and to bear one another's burdens and so fulfill the law of Christ.
