Here is a thought from last week's homily, *Kindness is the goodness of love. It is the first face of love. Unrelenting kindness draws people to want what you have. What you have is Jesus.*

Love expresses itself in marriage by way of *goods*. The love of marriage is to be for the good of the spouse, for the good of children, and for the good of the sacrament.

God does not want marriage to be a burden, something to be endured, fifty years of trial and testing and then you die. God wants marriage to be good for you! The spousal love is to inspire each person to seek greater holiness. It is to call forth all that is good in you and make it better. It is to sand down your rough edges and polish all that is dull in your faith, hope and love. Indeed, spousal love calls for self-sacrifice--this is the essence of love. To give of yourself for the good of another, until death, is the model of love Jesus gave the world. Do you love your spouse first and yourself second? Do you love spouse more than any earthly thing? Do you inspire your spouse to seek greater holiness every day? Be good to one another. Be good for one another. Marriage is to be for your good.

Marriage is for the good of children. The essence of marital love is to be open to the gift of children and then to give them everything they need to praise God in this life and to be with God forever in the life to come. Children bring to light the deepest love God has placed in our hearts. You would give your life for your children--that is the way God made us! There is a little something awry in a culture that seeks to measure God's gifts with chemical and mechanical contraception and abortion. God love is fruitful! It is incarnate in spousal love.

The love of husband and wife is to be for the good of the sacrament! Marriage is a sacrament and an institution that is bigger than those who happened to be living it now. Your marriage is a symbol of the sacrament of marriage! You have an obligation to the sacrament to live your marriage well, to nurture your love, to seek the health and healing of your spousal relationship. If you go out to dinner, your marriage is a sign to the table server of marriage. It is a sign of marriage to the teenagers in the next booth. It is a sign to the world that God's love is faithful, fruitful and enduring.
