Here is a thought from last week's homily, *Our King waits for us, he thirsts for us. He is not satisfied with half a heart or a portion of our free will. Jesus wants all of us, the whole of our being and each of us.*

Thank you for the kind wishes, cards and many gifts in celebration of Christmas. I am thankful to you and for this assignment as your pastor.

The liturgical year never rests! As I write this (January 5) we are still in the Season of Christmas, and I am already looking at the calendar for Lent. One of my goals is to make the Sacrament of Penance available to you. Jesus loves you. He wants you to receive the fruits of his passion, to know his mercy and to be free from sin and its ugly effects.

Here is a New Year's resolution for you to consider: to examine your conscience daily and to receive the Sacrament of penance at least 12 times in the next year. It may seem like a lot to receive the Sacrament twelve times a year, especially if your practice has been to receive it once or twice a year.

For those who seek to take the spiritual life most seriously, an annual confession is not enough. We need to humble ourselves before the Lord at least once a month. We need to work hard to free ourselves from the daily sins that undermine our ability to love and to be loved. If we receive the Sacrament only once a year, it is unlikely that we will make progress in the life of Christian perfection.

Here is a New Year's resolution for you: I will receive the Sacrament of Penance at least once a month.
