Christmas is over! I am sure that this is not news to you. The Valentine's Day boxed candy at every store and corner is a sure sign that the seasons have changed.

It is a marvel to see garbage cans in driveways on December 26. They are filled to overflowing from the packaging that entombed our gifts. There were somewhere between 25 and 30 million live Christmas trees used in the United States this year. With approximately 300 million Christmas trees growing on tree farms, this is a renewable resource. Even if they will never run out, there is still a cost to the atmosphere that contributes to the joy of Christmas.

The book of Genesis tells us that God created man and woman entrusting them with the task of filling the earth and subduing it, which does not mean exploiting it, but nurturing and protecting it, caring for it through their work. (5/1/13)
