Here is a thought from last weekend's homily: *Somewhere between subtle and self-centered is a witness of holy joy that, of its nature, will be attractive to people.*

Every day I begin my morning prayer by renewing my consecration to the Mother of God. Here is what I pray, "Mary, my Mother, I love you. I give myself to you, as your possession and property. Please make of me, of all that I am and have, whatever most pleases you. Let me be a fit instrument in your immaculate and merciful hands for bringing the greatest possible glory to God. Amen."

I knew that I would be receiving a new assignment many months before it was decided that I would be sent here. Not knowing you or even the possibility of coming here, I made a commitment to myself and to the Mother of God: I decided that my first pastoral initiative would be to invite the members of the parish to join me in consecrating my pastorate and the parish to Mary, the Mother of God.

I invite you to join me in a 33 day retreat beginning August 13, 2015. All that you need to do is buy a book and join in the short daily meditations. If you live with a spouse and/or children, I recommend praying the daily meditations together as a family. I have personally purchased 24 copies of the book; 18 of them are available at Sacred Heart and 6 of them are available at Assumption of Mary. This month's CD is "Prayer, the Gateway to the Spiritual Life", by Archbishop Paul Coakley. Archbishop Coakley was a priest in the Diocese of Wichita, Kansas, for 21 years. He was ordained the Bishop of Salina, Kansas, in 2004, and was installed as Archbishop of Oklahoma City in 2011. In this presentation given at the Rediscover Catholic Celebration in Minneapolis, Archbishop Coakley reflects on his journey and discusses the essential role of prayer to the spiritual life. One person commented that the Archbishop gives hope to parents whose children have gone astray, evidence of Mary's constant care when we stay in touch with her, and a reminder that we can always trust our loving, merciful God.
