Here is a thought from last week's homily: *That is a pretty good mission statement for a parish and a family—to feed, heal, teach and forgive.*

What are some things that the Diocese of Crookston is able to provide a parish that we cannot provide for ourselves? A pastor for one! Bishop Hoepfner will be here to install me as your pastor at the regular 5:30 PM Mass on Saturday, August 22, 2015. I hope that you will be able to welcome him.

It is a long road to become a priest. This road involves four to six years of seminary *after* college. As you may imagine, this education is very expensive. Today the Diocese of Crookston spends approximately \$40,000 per year per seminarian for the education and formation of our future priests. Last year there were seven men in seminary—wow! Although this is a blessing, our diocesan seminarian endowment is not able to fund the present need!

Fr. Ilango, your former pastor, was not a priest of the Diocese of Crookston when he was in seminary. The cost of his education was born by his home diocese in India. This being true, there are still costs associated with bringing foreign-born priests to service in the Diocese of Crookston. From the first inquiry to a priest having his feet on the ground here in northwest Minnesota, it takes approximately one year. During that year there are legal fees and immigration fees, and a lot of office time spent in coordinating this effort. This was part of my work as Vicar General of the Diocese of Crookston. The Diocese of Crookston does this for us!

It is vitally important for the work of the Diocese of Crookston that all of the parishes put forth a good effort to meet their goal for the Diocesan Annual Appeal. We are approximately \$4,000 short of our goal of \$17,675. The Diocesan Annual Appeal Summer Appeal is being held the weekend of August 16. If you have not yet contributed to the DAA, will you consider a gift? Approximately thirty percent of our households have already contributed to the Appeal in 2015. Thank you. If you have not yet been able to make an offering, I hope that you will consider a gift. If you are not able to offer 1% of your income, please consider a gift of any amount. If you have already contributed, perhaps you would consider an additional gift. At the present time there are NO members of the parish who belong to the Bishop's Guild, which required a minimum gift of \$1200.00.

I will share more about what the Diocese of Crookston does for us next week.
