I was born and raised in Hillsboro, ND, the eighth of eleven children. My father was a car dealer and my mother was a nurse. Dad went home to heaven on February 6, 2001. Mother is very much alive on earth. She will be 85 years old on September 3, but you didn't hear it from me.

My seven brothers and I grew up in the repair shop of the Ford dealership, which was as much home as the family home. We were the maintenance crew for the dealership, with dad at the lead. We serviced cars, detailed them and most of my brothers repaired them. I didn't get too much past water pumps and starters. The introduction of computer technology into automobiles pretty much ended my car repair days. There are no amateurs working in repair shops today.

When mother wasn't busy delivering babies, she delivered babies! She was an OB nurse for the first three quarters of her career. When liability insurance for doctors sky rocketed, the delivery rooms of small-town hospitals were closed, and she moved from caring for babies to caring for the elderly. The last ten years of her full-time work were in the Hillsboro nursing home. Even now she spends a lot of time at the nursing home, both as a volunteer and visiting her friends.

From this family a vocation was born. I was ordained a priest in 1990. Both times I have been appointed pastor previously it was to clusters of three parishes. Now, serving only two, I feel like the luckiest priest in the diocese!

I hope to be with you a good long while. In our time together we have a mutual duty and privilege: to help each other get to heaven! For my part, I will administer the sacraments, preach the gospel with courage and compassion and teach what the Catholic Church holds to be true and good. I hope to meet you in your homes and in your work and recreation.

Thank you for the warm welcome. If you see a priest with a smile on his face, it is likely me. I am so happy to be here.
