Here is a thought from last week's homily, *The Sacred Heart of Jesus is wounded by our sins, by our apathy when it comes to loving God and neighbor. The Sacred Heart of Jesus is wounded by our negligence in gratitude and our half-hearted praise.*

Here are some thoughts from the Catechism of the Catholic Church regarding family, children, catechesis and prayer.

2685 The Christian family is the first place of education in prayer. Based on the sacrament of marriage, the family is the "domestic church" where God's children learn to pray "as the Church" and to persevere in prayer. For young children in particular, daily family prayer is the first witness of the Church's living memory as awakened patiently by the Holy Spirit.

2688 The catechesis of children, young people, and adults aims at teaching them to meditate on the Word of God in personal prayer, practicing it in liturgical prayer, and internalizing it at all times in order to bear fruit in a new life. Catechesis is also a time for the discernment and education of popular piety.<sup>46</sup> The memorization of basic prayers offers an essential support to the life of prayer, but it is important to help learners savor their meaning.
