Here is a thought from last week's homily: *Who is Jesus? The suffering servant. The cornerstone rejected by the builders. The crucified one. The risen one. In light of Jesus, my identity still needs to be refined.*

On Monday, I stopped at a small convenience gas station a few miles from Elbow Lake on HWY 113. The clerk watched me fill a gas can. When I went to pay for it he asked, "Is that gas for work or for fun?" He seemed disappointed that I was going to mow my brother's lawn.

It was the first time starting the mower and the trimmer. That tells you how long the grass was! Long before the machines were running, my arm and shoulder were sore from pulling the starter ropes. I wonder if that is how the Holy Spirit feels when prompting us to surrender to God's will? The Holy Spirit primes us with intuition and inspiration. When God's will is clear to us, it is as if the Holy Spirit is pulling on our starter cord. Still we resist. Why? Sometimes we don't trust that God will give us what we need to accomplish his will. Sometimes we don't want to surrender our own agendas, plans, hopes and dreams. When we fail to run with God, our hearts are flooded with sorrow—eventually—every time.

I have been thinking about the convenience store attendant's question, "Is that gas for work or for fun?" The first 20 minutes of mowing was fun. The next three hours were work. Often our days are filled with a mixture of both. We don't often describe obedience to the Holy Spirit as fun. But it does bring peace and comfort.

When we eat, we fuel our bodies. You will be nourished by the Lord today. "Is that fuel for work or for fun?" It is the Lord's Day—it is for FUN! For the rest of the week, it may be more for work: the work of supporting your family, spreading the gospel and ourselves, drawing just a little closer to Jesus.
