Kindly take these questions to your heart as they come from your brother who loved and served you for seven years. Our relationship will never end here. It continues until we meet in heaven. I thank you all once again for your generosity in being with me as wonderful brothers and sisters. You are most welcome to join me in the Holy Eucharist in Sacred Heart, East Grand Forks on July 18<sup>th</sup>, when Bishop Michael Hoepfner is going to install me as the new pastor there. God bless you and see you soon again.
