Here is a thought from last week's homily, *We are to partake of the Cross of Jesus. However a share of his cross comes to you, embrace it. Bear it with all of your strength. When you fall, get back up again. When you cannot carry the burden, beg the Lord to send Simon to help you. We partake of the Cross of Jesus Christ so that we share also in his Resurrection and his life.*

The Sunday after Easter is Divine Mercy Sunday. Divine Mercy Sunday is a unique opportunity for us to bask in the Father's Mercy. God the Father, who searched after the lost sheep, who kissed the prodigal son upon his return, who rejoiced when one sinner repents. God the Father loves us and aches for us to accept his mercy. Once we have basked in this mercy, we are compelled to share it!

I know that it may seem awkward to invite someone to accompany you to Mass. Isn't there someone in your life, near your home, from childhood or from your family, that is suffering because s/he is not connected to the Sacraments? Can you find a way to invite them to Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday? Set aside your fears and anxieties. There is no pressure. There is always freedom. Share with someone what Jesus had done for you and invite them to come to Mass. What's your story? What is the one blessing you can share over and over again, to as many people who will listen? Invite them!
