Here is a thought from last week's homily: *When we speak of people and their dispositions toward God, we never have the right to describe them as destroyed or ruined (lost). Only God can make this judgment and, so long as a person lives, conversion is possible.*

Heads up: in the following encounter, I gave the WRONG answer! We had a funeral at Sacred Heart on Tuesday, All Saints Day, which is a Holy Day of Obligation. Several people asked me if the funeral Mass satisfies the obligation to attend Mass for the Holy Day. My first reaction was, "No." I explained, "The readings and the prayers are not for the Holy Day, so the obligation is not satisfied." I was wrong!

We are required to attend Mass on Holy Days and Sundays. This requirement is satisfied even when the prayers and readings for the day are not used. For example, if you attend a Wedding Mass on Saturday after 4:00 PM, your Sunday obligation is satisfied. If you attend a funeral during the day of a Holy Day of Obligation, the obligation is satisfied.

Isn't it wonderful that we can learn things every day? Isn't it wonderful that we can learn again things we once knew but have forgotten? I am sure that there will be more of that happening for me! ☺
