Here is a thought from last week's homily: *We take the first leap by following the commandments, then we must allow the love of God to span the distance between our feeble faithfulness and eternal life.*

My father died on February 6, 2001. He was ice fishing with a small group of friends on Lake of the Woods and suffered a heart attack while disassembling the portable ice house. They were approximately thirty miles onto the lake. It was more than an hour for the first responders to reach them—there was no hope of resuscitation at that point.

In the year prior to his death, my parents made arrangements for their own funerals. Dad had picked out his own casket and vault. Mother had taken notes regarding his funeral Mass. They had even paid for the funeral in advance. This was a great blessing to our family! I have assisted many families in making funeral arrangements for a loved one. Grief and guilt and ordinary family squabbles can make these arrangements difficult at best and divisive and hurtful at worst. What a gift my parents gave to the family by making these plans ahead of the need. The only thing we needed to do was love and support one another—there were no decisions to be made at a time when making decisions would have been very difficult.

It was my father's desire that his body be given a traditional burial. Cremation is a popular choice for many people. The National Conference of Catholic Bishops has written a beautiful reflection on cremation. I encourage you pick one up, read it, and share it with other Catholic families.

November, and especially All Souls Day, is a time to remember our departed loved ones and pray for them. Please plan to attend Mass on November 2 at 5:30 pm..
