Here is a thought from last week's homily: *If we cannot be docile and subservient to one another, we will fail to seek and respect the will of God.*

This past week you all should have received a mailing from the Diocese of Crookston and Covenant Eyes. Do not ignore this mailing and do not throw it away. If you cannot use it, give it to a family that uses computer technology at home or give it to any family with children.

"Pornography is any image that leads a person to use another person for their own sexual pleasure. It is devoid of love, intimacy, relationship, or responsibility. It can be highly addictive."

The average of first exposure to internet pornography is 11 years old. The largest consumers of internet pornography are kids ages 12 to 17. Here are some more facts:

- 73% of kids are exposed to pornography before 18
- 67% of kids admit to cleaning their browser history to hide Internet use from their parents
- 42% of kids first viewed pornography before 13
- 25% of kids are unwillingly exposed to nudity online when they aren't looking for it
- 57% of girls and 83% of boys have seen group sex on the internet
- 55% of girls and 69% of boys have seen porn showing same-sex intercourse
- 18% of girls and 32% of boys have viewed bestiality on the Internet
- 9% of girls and 15% of boys have seen child pornography

In this week's gospel, we hear Bartimaeus say to Jesus, "Master, I want to see." We pray the Lord Jesus to open our eyes to see the vulnerability of children and to do something to help them. Let us pray for chastity and purity in our own lives and in the lives of all those we love.
