I am Fr. Irenaeo. I am happy to be with you good people of St. Colman's parish. Let me tell you a little bit about my ministry. I serve 82 parishes in a third world country—to most of the parishes there are no roads. I travel by motor cycle over the natural countryside. I manage to get to each of my parishes about once a year. When I arrive a line forms for confessions. There will be many people wanting to receive the sacrament, as many as 200 at once. When I am finished with confessions we will have Mass. My parishes sponsor an orphanage. Today we have 123 children to care for. These children are the future of our country. In fact, they may have an advantage over other children because they will receive an education, as well as food and shelter. These children will be future doctors and teachers. We are so grateful for the support of the people at St. Coleman

It is hard for us to imagine these living circumstances! Let us be grateful for every gift! Let us be generous in caring for those in need here and everywhere.
