Here is a thought from last week's homily: *How does a person get into your home? They are either a thief or they need to be invited. So...how does God get into your home? God is not a thief, but the evil one is. God waits to be invited.*

I will be teaching a canon law class to men preparing for the permanent diaconate. It will be a twelve-hour class covering an overview of the Code of Canon Law, the Christian Faithful, Sacraments of Initiation, Marriage and Holy Orders and other acts of divine worship. The students will have to write one short paper in which they will present a nagging question related to the law of the church and formulate an answer.

I will be offering excerpts of the class at Sacred Heart in Frazee. Are you interested in learning more about canon law? Now is your chance! We will have four sessions after Saturday Evening Masses. The dates are: September 24, October 15, November 12 and December 17. Those attending are asked to bring an hors d'oeuvre to share with the group.

Here is a little something to whet your appetite:

Canon 265: Every cleric must be incardinated either in a particular church or personal prelature, or in an institute of consecrated life or society endowed with this faculty, in such a way that unattached or transient clerics are not allowed at all.

Excited yet? There will be NO writing assignment for our class, but you will be able to ask your nagging questions.
