Here is a thought from last week's homily, *From the cross Jesus gazes upon you. From Heaven the Father beholds you. At your side the Holy Spirit of Love presses to be near you. Joseph and Mary intercede for you without pause. There is no need to look back at our sins and failures. Let us press on, seeking heaven's appreciation for all that we do.*

Pope Francis announced that week that there will be changes to the annulment process. We are looking forward to more information from the Holy See and from our own Tribunal regarding the specific changes. Here are a few thoughts to ponder in the meantime.

Many people are distant from Catholic Church because of divorce and remarriage. This may be an opportunity for us to be able to reach out to them in a new way. The annulment process is not going to go away, but it will become less burdensome. Maybe this will be the news for which some of our family and friends have been waiting.

Please pray for Catholics who have been distant from the practice of our great faith because of divorce and remarriage. Pray that the Holy Spirit will prompt them to take another look at the Catholic Church and our parish and that we may be prepared to welcome them.

It is good for us to remember a few things. That fact of a divorce does not affect one's status in the Catholic Church. A divorced person can receive the sacraments and participate in the liturgy and in the life of the parish fully.

A Catholic who has been divorced and has remarried without the approval of the Catholic Church is not in full communion with the Church and is not to receive Holy Communion while this irregular situation exists. Still, this person has an obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. This person can come forward for a blessing at the time for Holy Communion. We need to be careful to never judge a person who abstains from the reception of Holy Communion. We probably need to grow in our hospitality—that ALL are welcome at Mass even though not all will receive Holy Communion.

Any Catholic who is in a state of serious sin should go to confession before receiving the Eucharist. I am available for confessions every Thursday morning at 8:30 AM, Saturday afternoons at 4:30 PM and Sunday mornings at 7:45 AM.—=

During this time of transition for our Tribunal, please pray for Bishop Hoepfner and for the Tribunal staff. Please pray that the new procedures will be a fruitful means of restoring people to Holy Communion and the full practice of the Catholic faith.
