Here is a thought from last week's homily: *For those who have been caught up in sin for a long time, imagine this: It is a thousand times easier to come back to God than to come home to the bleak criticism of self-righteous people.*

Joseph Lawrence Anthony Hollcraft was 22 years old when a drunk driver smashed into his car some hours before his death on August 30, 2016. From his obituary, "Joseph was a humble, simple, selfless young man, who left an impression on everyone he met; he sought people with the Lord and was a calming presence to those around him; by his example he inspired people to be their best and had a way of making everyone feel special and loved; he had a pure radiating joy that spilled over, filling those he loved - family, neighbors and strangers."

Another family needs to somehow find peace with the tragic loss of one of its loved ones. Please pray for his parents Monica and Ray, and for his siblings Maria, Aaron, Rachel, Hannah and Gianna. Pray for all families who have lost loved ones too early in life. This is a grief that is persistent and enduring. We cannot run from it. We must let it mold our hearts with a longing for the Kingdom of Heaven and the great reunion that is the Communion of Saints.

A Statement from Archbishop Joseph E. Kurtz of Louisville, President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops: *The recent storms in Louisiana may not have a name, but the names of those suffering in the wake of the worst flooding since Hurricane Katrina are our sisters and brothers. As President of USCCB, I have called for an emergency collection...to support the humanitarian efforts of Catholic Charities USA and to provide pastoral and rebuilding support to impacted Catholic dioceses...Whether your donation is large or small, let us also be sure those suffering feel the power of our prayer to sustain them in the difficult days ahead.*
