Here is a thought from last week's homily: *When anyone cries out for Jesus, it is wrong for us to silence them. It is wrong of us to judge that their petitions have no merit. It is wrong for us to withhold petitions to the Lord on their behalf.*

In the instruction and formation of our people, it is vitally important that we provide the opportunity to *encounter* Jesus. Most of us are not moved to faith by intellectual propositions, creeds or academic study. We are moved to faith when God speaks to us in prayer, when our hearts are swollen with the knowledge that we are loved and when we come to deeply regret and rue the day of our first sin and every day we have sinned since then.

I believe Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is a principal way we can, on a regular basis, invite people to encounter the person of Jesus Christ. We believe that Jesus Christ is present in the Blessed Sacrament. When we sit in Exposition, we sit with Jesus. When we gaze at the consecrated host, Jesus gazes back at us. When we quiet ourselves in his presence, we invite the Lord to speak to us, to comfort us, to heal us, to convict us and to affirm us.

I want us to more intentionally integrate prayer before our Lord and Savior into our life as a parish. When we have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, make a sacrifice and come to the Church to pray, even if it is for a short time. When we have meetings, we can pray before the Blessed Sacrament. When we are offering education or formation to any age demographic, we can allot some portion of the time to prayer before the Lord.

*Lord our God, in this great sacrament we come into the presence of Jesus Christ, your Son, born of the Virgin Mary and crucified for our salvation. May we who declare our faith in this fountain of love and mercy drink from it the water of everlasting life. We ask this through Christ our Lord.*
