Speaking of Dad, do you remember that Dad owned and managed a car dealership? For my entire life at home, neither Mom or Dad owned a car. They drove cars from the dealership. Mom would have a car until there was a perspective buyer, then it would be reconditioned, and she would get another. Still today, it seems odd for me to "own" a car and to drive a car for more than a month! The summer Dad died, Mom bought a new car. It is a 2001 Mercury Sable and is a rusted old car today. I am sure it is the last car she will own. It has about 60,000 miles on it. Today she has trouble with the battery, because she does not drive it enough. Maybe the car needs to see an electrophysiologist.

It seems that I have enough excitement in my life to keep my heart rate at a normal pace. Thank you for all you do to keep me electrified!
